

Spay Neuter Information for NH Residents

Animal Rescue Veterinary Services (ARVS), Dr. Trahan

Eligibility Requirements: We offer clinics to spay and neuter your dogs, cats and rabbits. Your pet must be healthy and less than 5 years old.

Appointment: Your pet will have surgery, be given pain medications, have toe nails clipped, be treated for fleas and ear mites, and be given rabies and distemper vaccines. All cats will need to come to the clinic in a safe carrier (one cat per carrier) with a towel in it. Your pet will go home the same day as the surgery and need to rest for 7 days after surgery.

NEW HAMPSHIRE SPCA - STRATHAM

Eligibility Requirements: Only for cat owners. Prices are subject to change based on financial need. Call for prices based on your financial need.

Fees: Cats only, \$100 for female and \$80 for male. (Price includes nail trims)

- \$20 rabies vaccine if needed.
- \$25 micro-chipping (optional)

\$10 flea/tick preventative (optional) \$10 E-collar (optional)

\$20 Distemper Vaccine (optional)

Non-refundable payment is due in full at time of registration. Cash or credit only. No checks please. *Procedure:* Call 603-772-2921 ext.147

Animal Population Control Program Plan B (Concord, NH)

Eligibility Requirements: Discounts for qualified low income families. To be eligible to participate in this program you must be on one of the seven programs: Food Stamps, Medicaid or Healthy Kids Gold, TANIF, The Old Age Assistance Program, Supplemental Security Income Program, Aid to the Needy Blind Program, APTD Program. A person may also be qualified if they meet the income guidelines for the program. Can only provide assistance for 3 animals every 5 years. *Fees:* \$25 per animal which includes spay or neuter and \$15 towards a rabies vaccination. *Procedure:* Call 603-271-3697 for guidelines or go to <u>http://agriculture.nh.gov/divisions/animal-industry/animal-population-control.htm for an application/</u>. It can take 10-14 days for an application to be approved.

Greater Nashua Humane Society-Nashua, NH

Eligibility Requirements: Must be a cat owner or a male dog owner. Offers low cost vaccination clinics and low cost spay/ neuter clinics. Clinics are only held on Wednesdays from 10-12pm and 1-2:30pm. Only accept cash or credit for payment.

Fees: Female and male cats \$95. Male dogs: \$200. No Female Dogs.

Procedure: Call 603-889-2275 ext 30. to schedule an appointment or for more information. You can also visit their website at www.hsfn.org. Can take up to 72 hours for them to get back to you as there is a high demand. Appointments are typically scheduled 1 month out.



Friends of Animals Program-National Program

Eligibility Requirements: You must be a cat or dog owner regardless of financial need. *Fees:* Dogs are \$110 for females and \$74 for males. Cats are \$85 for females and \$61 for males. *Procedure:* Obtain an application and find a vet that participates in your area by calling 1-800-321-7387. Merrimack River Feline Rescue Society - Catmobile

Locations are subject to change (mobile unit)

Fees: Female cats \$120, Male cats \$80. Qualified feral cats are \$60 (free clinics on Sundays). *Feral cats:* Free only on Sunday (donations welcomed). Email: sundayclinic@mrfrs.org *Appointment:* Includes a brief exam, spay/neuter surgery, rabies vaccination if needed, FVRCP vaccination if needed and nail trim.

Procedure: To make an appointment with the Catmobile call 978-465-1940 or go to <u>www.catmobile.org</u> for online booking. Drop off is at 8:15am and pick up time is determined upon arrival. Pick up and drop off will be outside the cat mobile. Pick up is same day.

New Hampshire Humane Society-Laconia,NH (SNAP)

Eligibility Requirements: SNAP is designed to help those individuals who cannot afford spay/neuter surgery and who do not qualify for other spay/neuter assistance programs. Animals need to be between 5m- 6yrs, and dogs can't be above 50lbs. Animals must be current on rabies and distemper (records need to be brought) or an additional \$15 per shot will be charged.

Fees: \$150 for female cats, \$95 for male cats, \$175 for male dogs, \$250 for female dogs. Prices includes pain medication and an e-collar. Additional fees may apply depending if the animal is pregnant, or if additional procedures are requested.

Procedure: Please visit <u>www.nhhumane.org/snap.php</u> for an application or call 524-3252 ext. 304. Appointments are scheduled for every Tuesday.

Rozzie May Animal Alliance-Conway, NH

Eligibility Requirements: Need to own a cat or a dog. Male dogs must be under 100lbs and female dogs must be under 70lbs. Animal must be up to date on rabies or a rabies shot will be given. *Fees:* Female cats \$85, Male cats \$70, male dogs \$100-175 (depending on weight) and female dogs \$125-175 (depending on weight). If animal is pregnant or is a cryptorchid then an additional charge will be applied.

Appointment: Includes exam, rabies (if needed), capstar flea treatment, nail trim and ear cleaning. Additional services for an additional price are offered as well. Please call for more information. *Procedure:* Call 603-447-1373 or <u>visit www.rozziemay.org</u>. Vaccines also available and has mobile unit that travels to Berlin, Belmont, Farmington, Tilton, Plymouth, Ossipee, Wakefield, Rochester, Dover, and Brentwood.

Animal Welfare Society-Kennebunk, ME

Eligibility Requirements: Must own a cat or a dog. If the animal is over 6yrs then a pre-anesthetic blood must be conducted and an additional fee of \$30 will be charged.

Fees: Cats \$60, Male Dog \$150-\$210 (depends on weight) and Female Dog \$200-\$260 (depends on weight). Other services like rabies and microchips are offered for an additional price. Rabies vaccines are available for \$10. There are additional programs available for low income residents. *Procedure:* Visit <u>www.animalwelfaresociety.org</u> or call 207-985-3244 to set up an appointment.



Animal Allies-Manchester, NH

Eligibility Requirements: Cat owner who needs financial assistance getting their cat spayed/ neutered.

Fees: Female cats are \$90 and male cats are \$55.

Procedure: Call (603) 228-6755 or go to <u>www.animalallies.org</u> for more information. There are locations in Pembroke and Manchester and appointments are scheduled the second Friday of each month. Only cash is accepted for payment.

Animal Refuge League – Westbook, ME

Eligibility Requirements: Individuals interested must meet income guidelines to qualify for services. *Procedure:* Call 207-854-9771 ext. 4 for more info and pricing or visit <u>www.arlgp.org</u>.

Salem Animal Rescue League –Salem, NH

Eligibility Requirements: Mother cats only right now with litter. *Procedure:* Call (603) 893-3210 ext.202 or email <u>smaclatchy@sarlnh.org</u> for prices and more information.

Manchester Animal Shelter-Manchester, NH

Eligibility Requirements: Residents of Manchester for cat owners only. Also have a Fix a Pit program (free spay/neuter, free rabies, free microchip for pit bulls only). Rabies and Distemper vaccines are required.

Fees: \$95 for females and \$75 for males.

Procedure: Call 603-628-3544 or email info@manchesteranimalshelter.org.

Animal Rescue Vet Services-Londonderry, NH

Eligibility Requirements: Pet needs to be less than 5yrs old.

Appointment: Includes pain meds, toe nails clipped, treated for fleas and mites, rabies and distemper if needed.

Fees: Cats: (Female) \$100, (Male) \$75; Rabbits (Male and Female) \$200

Dogs: (Female) \$200-\$350 (depends on weight), Dogs (Male) \$180-\$300 (depends on weight) *Procedure:* Please call 603-425-3928 or visit <u>www.arvsonline.org</u> for more information. If you have proof of financial assistance they can work with you in regards to their prices.

Conway Humane Society, NH

Eligibility Requirements: Animals must be up to date on rabies and distemper.

Appointment: Includes an exam, nail trim, and ear cleaning. Rabies, Distemper, flea treatments, microchip and dewormer are offered for an additional price.

Fees: Cat (Male) \$70 (Female) \$85, Dog (Male) \$100-175 (depends on weight), (Female) \$125-175 (depends on weight).
